



Groundskeeper

- Job Description:** An employee in this class operates a variety of light, medium, and heavy equipment to perform routine established tasks such as mowing, repairing airstrips, and performing other landscaping tasks. Examples of work include mowing, asphalt patching, planting, mulching, fertilizing, and pruning. Employee also performs minor maintenance and servicing of equipment used. Work is performed under the immediate supervision of the Airfield Maintenance Supervisor and is evaluated through observation and inspection of work for adherence to established work standards.
- Principal Responsibilities:**
- Operates large motorized equipment such as large tractor mowers, slope mowers, weed eaters, backhoe, snow blowers, street sweepers, sidewalk sweepers, loaders, wood chipper, and dump trucks.
 - Washes and cleans equipment; performs routine servicing such as checking fluid levels and tire pressure.
 - Plants trees, shrubs, and grass; fertilizes, waters, mulches, trims, and performs other general landscape maintenance tasks.
 - Patches asphalt and/or concrete strips and other roadway areas.
 - Clears fence line, pesticide application.
 - Takes part in Snow removal Operations.
- Standard Work Hours:** Monday – Friday 7:00am – 3:00pm, Hours subject to change based on seasonal needs.
- Knowledge & Skills:**
- Working knowledge of the standard methods, traffic laws, and regulations governing heavy equipment operation.
 - Working knowledge of the occupational hazards involved and the safety precautions necessary to operate large equipment.
 - Some knowledge of landscaping methods and procedures.
 - Skill in operating and servicing equipment used in this position
 - Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
 - Ability to make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment.
 - Ability to communicate courteously with the public, coworkers, and supervisors.
- Minimum Requirements:**
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
 - Experience operating motorized equipment.
 - Ability to operate motorized equipment of various types and size.
- Preferred Requirements:**
- Previous experience in a lead worker or supervisory capacity, or any combination of education and experience that produces the required knowledge, skills, and abilities listed above.
